





Mildew resistant grapevines

- New generation no-spray mildew resistant grapevines will reduce chemical use, fuel and time
- These are another tool for the sector to use to enhance sustainability
- Other advantages include high colour and productivity and excellent flavour profiles

Under development – will roll out first network in NE Victoria for the 2022 vintage


- Site specific smoke assessment in real time

- Combines data from the vineyard with research to provide a risk assessment






