



# STRENGTHENING THE AUSTRALIA-CHINA RELATIONSHIP THROUGH WINE

The Australia-China winemaker immersion program is an industry exchange for emerging winemakers from China and Australia to experience wine, winemaking, and viticultural education in each other's markets.

The program fosters collaboration between the Australian and Chinese wine industries, building on the recently strengthened diplomatic, economic and cultural relationship between the two nations.

Supported by the Australian and Chinese wine industry associations - Australian Grape & Wine and the China Alcoholic Drinks Association - the program gives early-career winemakers a behind-the-scenes experience to build cultural and industry knowledge, cultivating the next generation of international winemaking talent.

The 2025 pilot program has 2 components:

**4 Chinese winemakers** visiting South Australia for the Australian vintage (April-March)

**4 Australian winemakers** visiting China during vintage (October-November)

The longer-term objective of the program is to create an alumni community of Australian and Chinese viticulturalists and winemakers with a deep cultural and technical understanding of the two markets, including production techniques, product innovation, consumer insights, sustainability, and adaptation strategies to respond to emerging industry challenges.

Participants will have a unique experience of the 2025 China vintage:

- > 4 winemakers
- > 10 October to 8 November, 2025
- > Regions visited: Beijing, Shanghai, Ningxia

### A HANDS-ON EXPERIENCE OF THE CHINESE WINE INDUSTRY

Early-career professionals from the viticulture and wine industry will have an immersive 4 week experience in China, with exposure to local viticulture practices, wine production, research and innovation, wine tourism, cellar doors, and wine education.

The wine production immersion component will be led by **Treasury Wine Estates** at its **Stone & Moon Winery** in Ningxia, with other content delivered by a range of technical experts from leading academic institutions and industry bodies.

Participants will experience:

- an overview of China's wine industry at China Agricultural University featuring academics, wine experts, and young winemakers from the Huailai winemaking region near Beijing
- > wine production techniques at Treasury Wine Estates' Stone & Moon Winery at Pigeon Mountain, at the foot of Ningxia's Helan Mountain
- > an immersion in the broader Ningxia wine region, including visits to Château Terroir, Ningxia Wine Bureau, Qingtongxia Wine Centre, as well as the Yongning and Yinchuan subregions
- academic sessions in winemaking and viticulture at Shanghai Jiao Tong University
- > the China International Import Expo annual trade fair in Shanghai the country's flagship trade event that features thousands of exhibitors from across the world and showcases products and services across a range of sectors

## NINGXIA WINERY EXPERIENCES

- > The Ningxia wine region in China's central-north features more than 40,000 hectares of vineyards, and is renowned for its Cabernet Sauvignon and Marselan blends, generous Chardonnays and crisp Rieslings, with plantings of Syrah and Merlot
- > The region's Yellow River supports vineyard irrigation, with most vineyard plantings in the foothills of Helan Mountain, with a continental climate of hot summers and cold winters
- > Many vineyards are planted at more than 1200 metres above sea level, where intense sunlight during the day and cool nights promote ideal ripening conditions and naturally balanced acidities
- > The region has had national and international investment in vineyards, wineries and tourism in recent decades
